### **Crossenvale Community House**

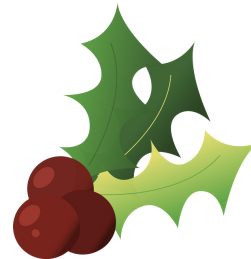
is looking for reception support volunteers. Days available are:
