ERH, Rochester and Kyabram key health services involved.</li> <li>• The Achievement Program staying in the plan for workplaces to be ongoing and includes key cancer prevention messages, around smoking and healthy eating active living.</li> <li>• A pilot community business pilot is being established with Coolabah Turf in Echuca to focus on cancer prevention measures within the community. A workplace audit around sunsmart, smoking, healthy eating, active living will be conducted as well as health checks for staff and strategies to support the business and their staff in these areas. This will be a pilot, then look at larger rolling out to workplaces with outdoor workers to focus on skin cancer prevention too.</li> </ul>
